

# Luma Connection #39: Peer-to-Peer Video Discussions

## Teaching Tool: LumaLive®

This is Luma's synchronous or same time meeting tool. This online tool allows learners to interact with each other to explore a topic and to discuss key concepts, share experiences, interact with each other, and to ask questions in real time. Interactions are in real-time and can be mentor-learner, learner-to-content, learner-to-self, and learner-to-learner.



## Tip: Peer-to-Peer Video Discussions

Including videos to engage learners in discussion topics is a fantastic way to engage and communicate with learners.

### Here are some tips for unlocking the power of "Why?" in a live discussion:

1. Decide on the video type you want learners to post. Keep them short (less than 30 seconds).
  - **Favorite Spot Videos.** Learners share a video of their favorite spot.
  - **Pet Videos.** Learners post a pet video.
  - **Job Tip.** Learners post a video about a tip to be successful in their job.
  - **Demonstration.** Learners post a video demonstration.
2. Learners share a link to their video and put it on LumaLive.
3. Hold round table discussions, and peers have to guess what the video is about.
  - **Favorite Spot Videos.** Peers guess what the learner likes about the spot.
  - **Pet Videos.** Peers write a story about what the animal is thinking.
  - **Job Tip.** Peers respond about their personal experiences.
  - **Demonstration.** Peers post a question.
4. Provide some structure around the expectation for peer responses and learner responses. Peers post two replies and learner responses to at least ½ of the comments, for example.
